ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

- Reviewed Senate Open Session speakers' request to consider a UA policy on donor interference, including the "Institutional Conflicts of Interest in Academia" provided by Open Session speakers at last Senate Meeting.
- Discussed ad hoc Committee on Career Track Faculty proposal to (1) form a permanent standing committee (in light of this ad hoc committee being #5 or #6 consecutive ad hoc groups) (2) integrate with an existing standing committee (e.g., APPC) or (3) continue as an ad hoc advisory group to the VP Faculty Affairs.

GOALS:

- Revisit GPSC proposal to change the gen ed policy with regard to graduate students as instructors of record.
- Continue to explore whether and how UA gift policies (and/or UA conflict of interest, conflict of
 commitment policies) explicitly address restrictions or provide guidelines regarding what donors
 can/cannot ask for or do when they give a gift.
